Simul with GM Timur Gareyev - February 27, 2017



Grandmaster and blindfold world record holder Timur Gareyev will be giving a simul at Arcadia Chess Club on February 27. GM Gareyev's impressive chess career includes winning the 2011 US Open, 2012 North American Open, 2014 American Open, 2014 Far West Open, and 2016 American Open. He has also played in the US Championship three times, finishing 3rd in 2013 only half a point behind eventual winner Gata Kamsky.

GM Gareyev is perhaps best known for his blindfold exploits. In December 2016, after a year of practice events, he took on 48 players simultaneously... all while not being able to see any of the boards. He finished with an amazing score of +35 =7 -6 and the event set a new world record for simultaneous blindfold chess.
